

DAT -> Opioid Court Participation: Potential Referral Pathways




Watertown: All Referral Sources





Law enforcement "flags" individuals who may be eligible for opioid court (based on their charge and/or appearance/context clues) on their forms for arraignment. Eligible folks are given arraignment dates within 3 days (shorter time frame) to reduce overdose risk.


Treatment




If anybody identifies a defendant with opioid use/overdose risk and Treatment is available at the courthouse, the defendant will be linked. Treatment will provide care to the defendant and obtain a release, so that they can connect them with the Opioid Court.

Probation/parole refer individuals with opioid use/overdose risk on their caseload to Opioid Court for additional monitoring and supervision, typically if they are at risk for violating probation/parole.
